The article reports on the modern approaches to individual and integral quantitative assessment of psychophysiological labour factors based on the criteria such as the degree of departure in labour difficulty and tensivity indices from the norm together with the differentiation of labour process into classes depending on labour conditions (optimum, permissible, harmful). The article produces the approbation results of the approaches and criteria of classifying the labour process based on studying the labour characteristics of 15 basic professions at mixed fodder enterprises. The results have shown the objectivity and information capacity of the approaches in determining the degree of harmfulness for both individual factors and the labour process on the whole.
